## FLOAT TEST

Every participant must successfully pass a float test prior to the first water session of a small craft class. It is also a membership requirement for boating organizations sponsored by the Seattle Parks and Recreation. In deep water, while wearing long pants and a long sleeve shirt, you must float, tread water, or swim in place for ten minutes. In the final minute of the test you must put on a life vest while continuing to tread water. A ten-minute float test is valid for three years. You must show ID.

Float tests must be taken at any swimming pool or beach under the supervision of a lifeguard certified by the American Red Cross. Regular pool admission is charged. This test cannot be administered at either small craft center.
